#### **Refunds/Cancellations**

You may cancel a class as long as it is at least two (2) business days prior to the beginning of each program. VDM will refund the entire program fee when the program is canceled for insufficient enrollment. (A minimum of 6 students is required to hold a class.) If your cancellation causes the program number to fall below the required minimum, the refund will be contingent upon the vacancy being filled. No refunds will be given after the program begins. Please call or email us. Unfortunately, you cannot cancel online.
