Sensory Soap Foam

Instructions:

- Add ½ cup warm water to your bowl.
- Squirt in a heavy dose of dish soap.
- Add one of your Kool Aid packets
- Mix with an electric hand mixer for 2-3 minutes until fluffy.

Optional: If you have a big, plastic tub, dump your fluffy suds into it and repeat the steps above with different colors.

Magic Milk

Instructions:

- Pour milk into the baking dish to cover the entire bottom surface of the container.
- Add drops of food coloring to the milk.
- Pour a small amount of dish soap into a bowl or cup, and touch the tip of a cotton swab into the soap.
- Gently touch the surface of the milk with the soap-covered swab.
- Watch as the colors move and swirl, as if by magic – but it's actually science!

Moon Rock Creation

Instructions:

- Mix 1 cup of water with 1 cup of flour in a mixing bowl.
- Add paint or food coloring to your mixture. (Optional: Make multiple colors for more variation to your rocks.)
- Line your baking sheet with aluminum foil.
- Dip cotton balls into the flour and paint mixture, then set them on your baking sheet.
- Add different colors of paint to the tops.
 (Optional: Sprinkle glitter on the tops of your rocks if you have any in the house.)
- Bake moon rocks in the oven at 300 degrees for 45 minutes.

Chromatography Butterfly

Instructions:

- Pour a few inches of water into a drinking glass.
- Draw a thick circle on a coffee filter with washable marker, leaving the center white.
- Pinch the coffee filter from the center to create a point and dip the point into the water in the glass. (Important: Prop the filter on the rim of the glass so that the marker does NOT touch the water in the glass.)
- Wait a few minutes and watch the colors spread up the coffee filter.
- Pull the coffee filter out and lay it flat to dry.
- When dry, accordion-fold the coffee filter and use a pipe cleaner to twist around the center to create a butterfly.



Leak-Proof Bag

Instructions:

- Make sure your pencils are all sharpened.
- Add water to your zip-lock plastic bag and close it tightly.
- Stick your pencils through the bag and see what happens!

Penny Cleaning Experiment

Instructions:

- Set one penny aside. This is called your control so you can compare the results.
- Put each of the other pennies into its own cup.
- In the first cup, pour enough vinegar to cover the penny. In the second cup, pour enough liquid dish soap to cover the penny. In the third cup, pour enough water to cover the penny.
- Wait at least 10 minutes. Remove the pennies, rinse them in water, and rub them with a paper towel.
- Compare all three pennies to your control penny. Which one is the shiniest?
